Seaside in Alghero, Sardinia...

Sardinia is one of the oldest territories of Europe, with little if none seismic risk at all.

Alghero is situated in North-West Sardinia, on the bay of the same name.

The villa stands on a private promontory, on the seashore, a few steps away from the city centre.





Alghero

A jewel set in the most beautiful stretch of coast of the Mediterranean, illuminated by the crystal-clear blue of the sea and the magnificence of art.

Nature has endowed it with beaches of the finest sand, blades of rock rising from the waves, caves that are thousands of years old and a climate to be envied. Man has enriched it with the most elegant campaniles and a historic centre without equal, the splendid fruits of Catalan presence. This is why Alghero has been a town for elite holiday-makers since the end of the 19th century, long before Sardinia became a destination for mass tourism.

Alghero is a pleasant little town with about 40.000 inhabitants, busy and lively throughout the year, which maintains particularly striking traditions. Unlike the Costa Smeralda, Alghero offers fun and entertainment both in summer and winter. The historic centre is one of the most beautiful in Sardinia and the villa is situated a short distance from it.

The large tourist port is a safe landing-place for boats of large dimensions, too; nearby the coral and filigree work of refined craftsmen is available.











The villa has an unusual history and soul. It rises at the edge of the sea, on a rocky promontory, with a well-established park separating it from the Alghero seafront. Built in around 1880 on the ruins of an ancient watch-tower at the will of Alessandro, third Count of St. Elijah, it was initially destined to be a hunter's cabin.

In 1910 the piers and surrounding walls were built, aimed at ensuring privacy and safety for guests.

Between 1918 and 1920 Don Luigi Arborio Mella, the fourth Count of St. Elijah, did important renovation work, urged on by his English wife Lady Rosamond Marke Wood: the building took on its shape vaguely inspired by the medieval castle, following the fashion of the time and the rank of the family. His brother Alberto had in the meantime become Chamberlain for Pope Pius XI, and kept this rank with Pius XII, too.

The villa thus became a meeting-place for the best society of the epoch; the Romanov princesses and Italian Royalty were habitual guests, in summer to swim in the sea, in winter for hunting.







Prestigious holiday

Alghero had already become a prestigious holiday place for numerous travellers of noble lineage by the end of the 19th Century, well before Sardinia was discovered by mass tourism.

During the Second World War the villa was the centre of the allied air command. One of the frequent visitors at that time was Antoine de Saint-Exupéry.

In 1959 Francesco Arborio Mella, fifth Count of St. Elijah, sold the villa to the current owners. The dwelling was renovated and another floor built, so that it took on its current shape. Still today habitual visitors include renowned statesmen, aristocrats and well-known personalities of the business and entertainment worlds. The view from its windows is, to say the least.





Location

Privacy, elegance, charm.



Details

This is one of the best villas in the Mediterranean: location, atmosphere and views are simply breathtaking.

The property consists of:

main building (Liberty-style villa originally belonging to the Counts of St. Elijah); situated in a panoramic position on its own promontory, with an area of approximately 1,923 square meters (about 20,699 SqFt).

25 rooms with bathroom (including 4 suites with sea view and terrace, 1 suite with park view and terrace and 2 suites with sea view), billiard, drawing rooms, dining hall, kitchens. Centralized air conditioning;

building with an area of approximately 492 square meters (about 5,296 SqFt) used as a Spa with fitness and beauty area (with massage cubicles, sun-shower and Jacuzzi), covered heated swimming-pool, sauna, Turkish bath, fun shower, Kneipp Walk, changing-rooms;

warehouses, store-rooms, staff changing-rooms, laundry, ironing-room, electricity generator; centralized air conditioning;

large parking area;

helipad;
